117. Training and Efficiency Scheme Options – Evaluations

Regimental Staff wishes to provide advance notice regarding a new format for T&E Scheme Evaluations starting in the 2009-2010 Training Year. In order to streamline the process, all T&E Evaluations for Optional Components of the T&E Scheme will be completed on pre-assigned dates: April 17, 2010 for Avalon Battalion and April 24, 2010 for Trinity Conception Battalion. Each Company will have a time slot allocated and location specified for them to complete its two options. Evaluations will be closed, meaning that Companies will not be permitted to observe evaluations of other Companies. The assigned dates are considered to be firm and will be the only opportunity for Companies to be evaluated for T&E Options. Please note that there is no change to the scheduling of Compulsory Drill, Colour Party and PT Evaluations; Companies will apply for these dates in the usual manner – by application to the Battalion Adjutants - and Examining Officers will visit Companies on an individual basis.
