**69. Training and Efficiency Scheme - Eligibility**

The Regimental Training Director would like to remind all Companies of the eligibility requirements for the various Training and Efficiency (T&E) Scheme programs. Specifically, it should be noted that officers are not permitted to participate in T&E evaluations. Adherence to this rule will ensure that all Companies are graded on an equal footing. Should a Company lack the required minimum number of participants for a given T&E evaluation, they are strongly encouraged to combine with another Company.

The following specific eligibility requirements for the Band Program will take effect this Training Year:

A band shall be comprised of members of the Senior Corps and/or Junior Training Corps, within the prescribed age limits up to the rank of Sergeant. The band will be under the field command of a Drum Major who shall be a Warrant Officer or Non-Commissioned Officer of the Company. The Bandmaster may be an adult leader of the CLB.
